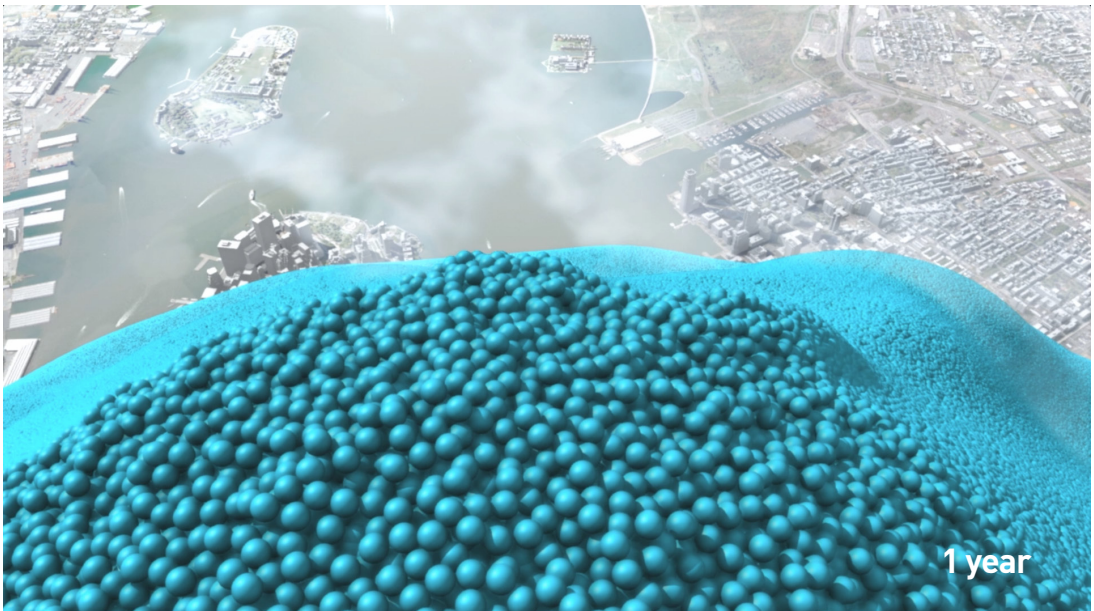
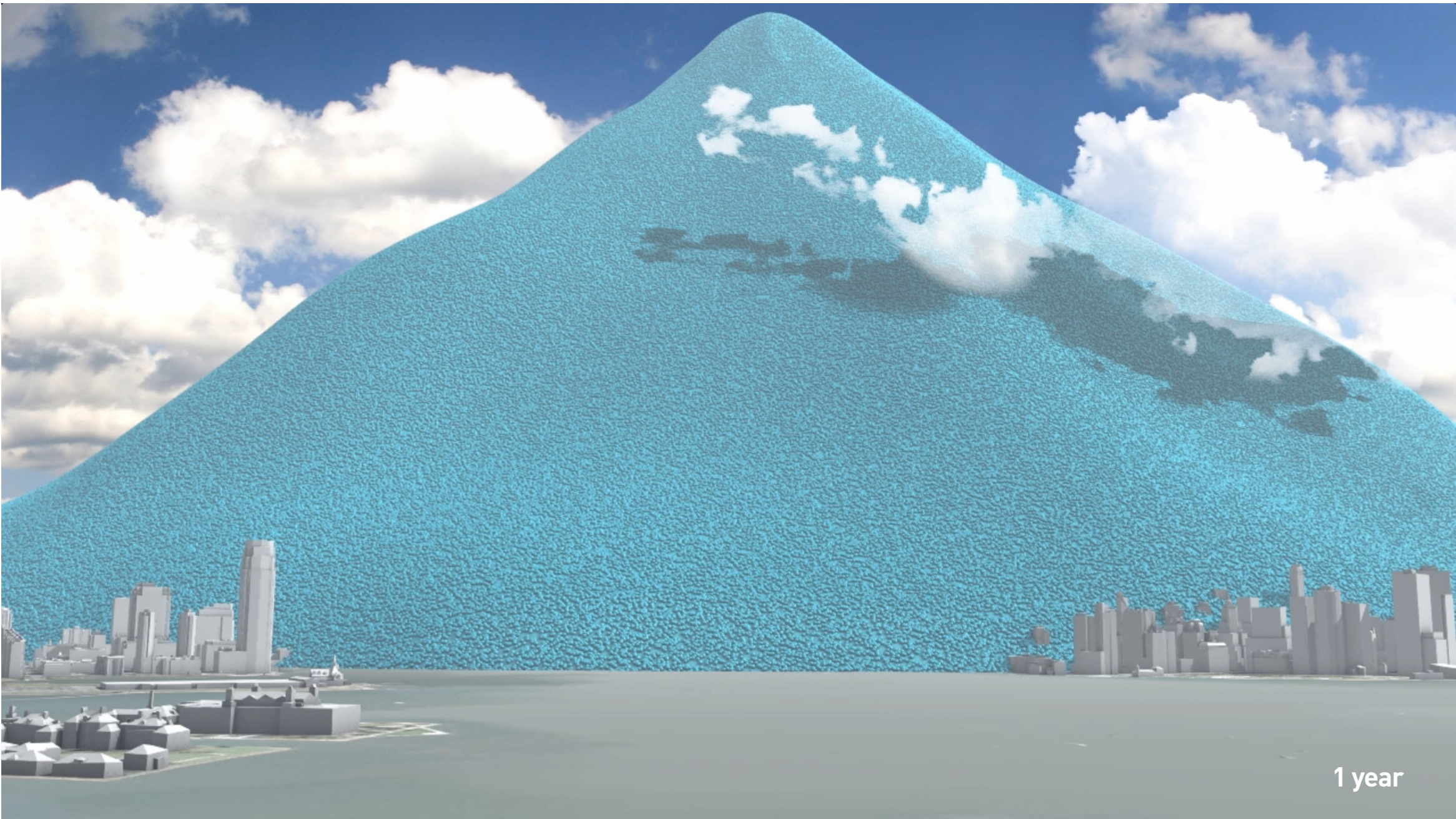
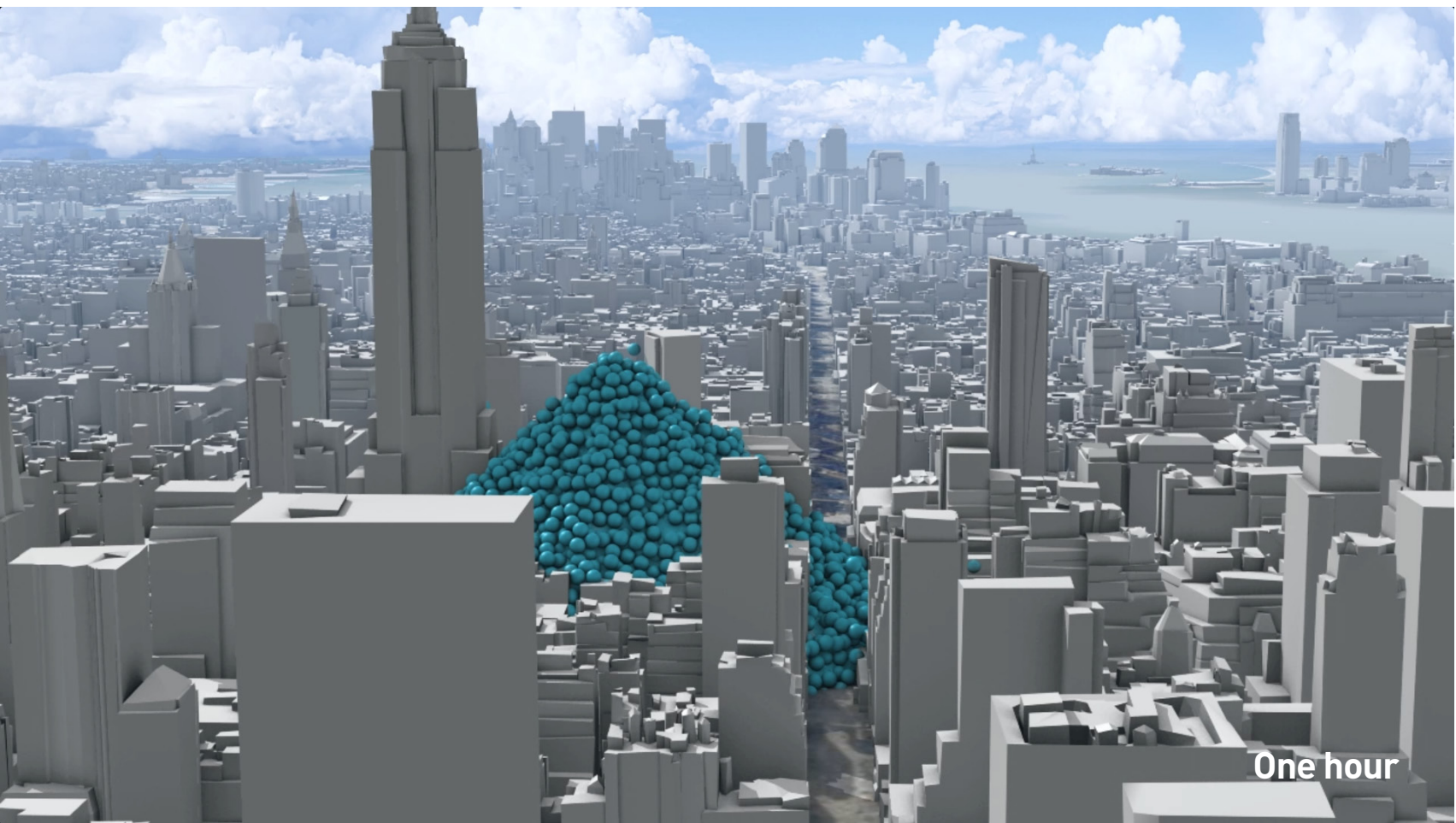
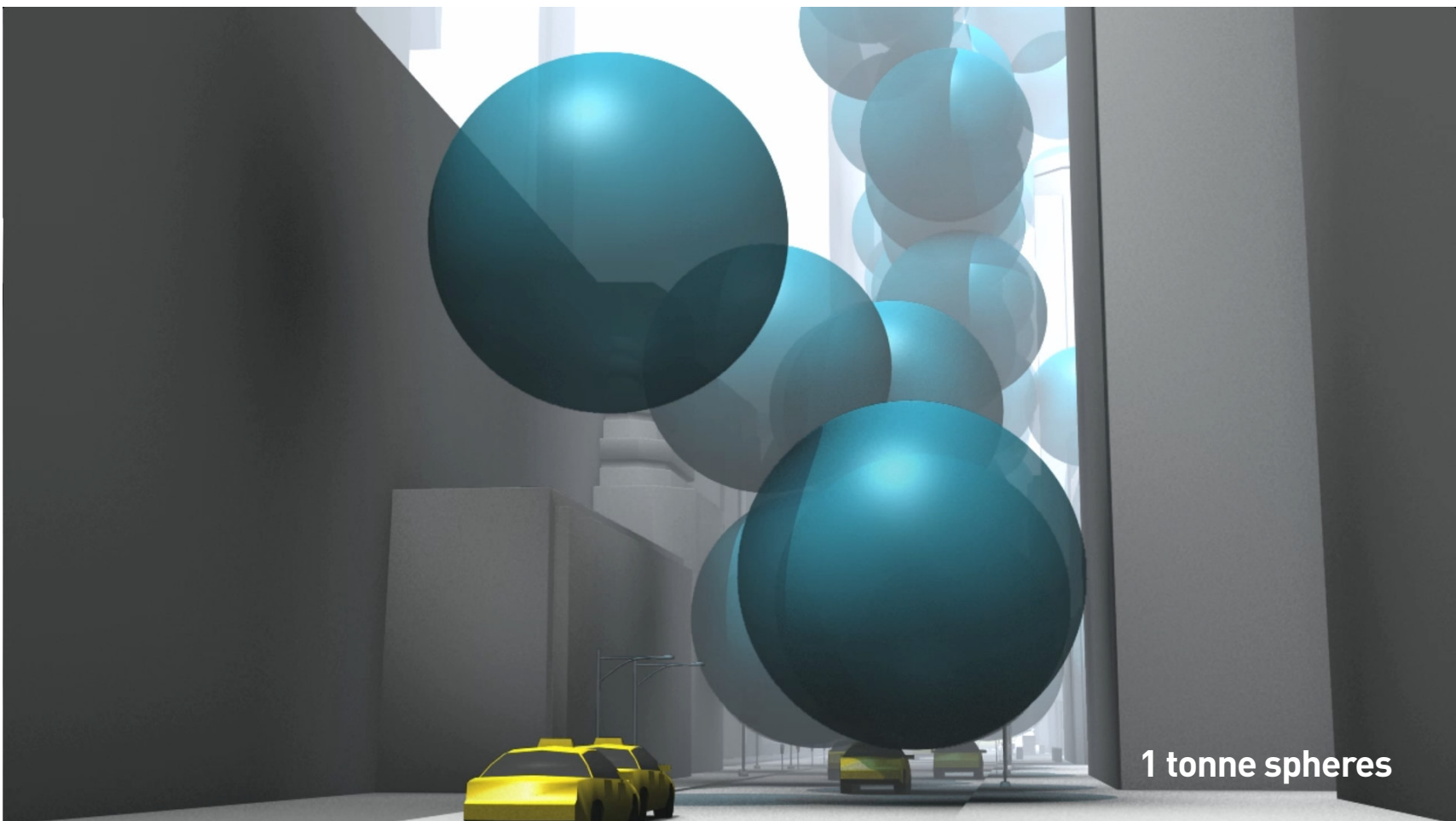
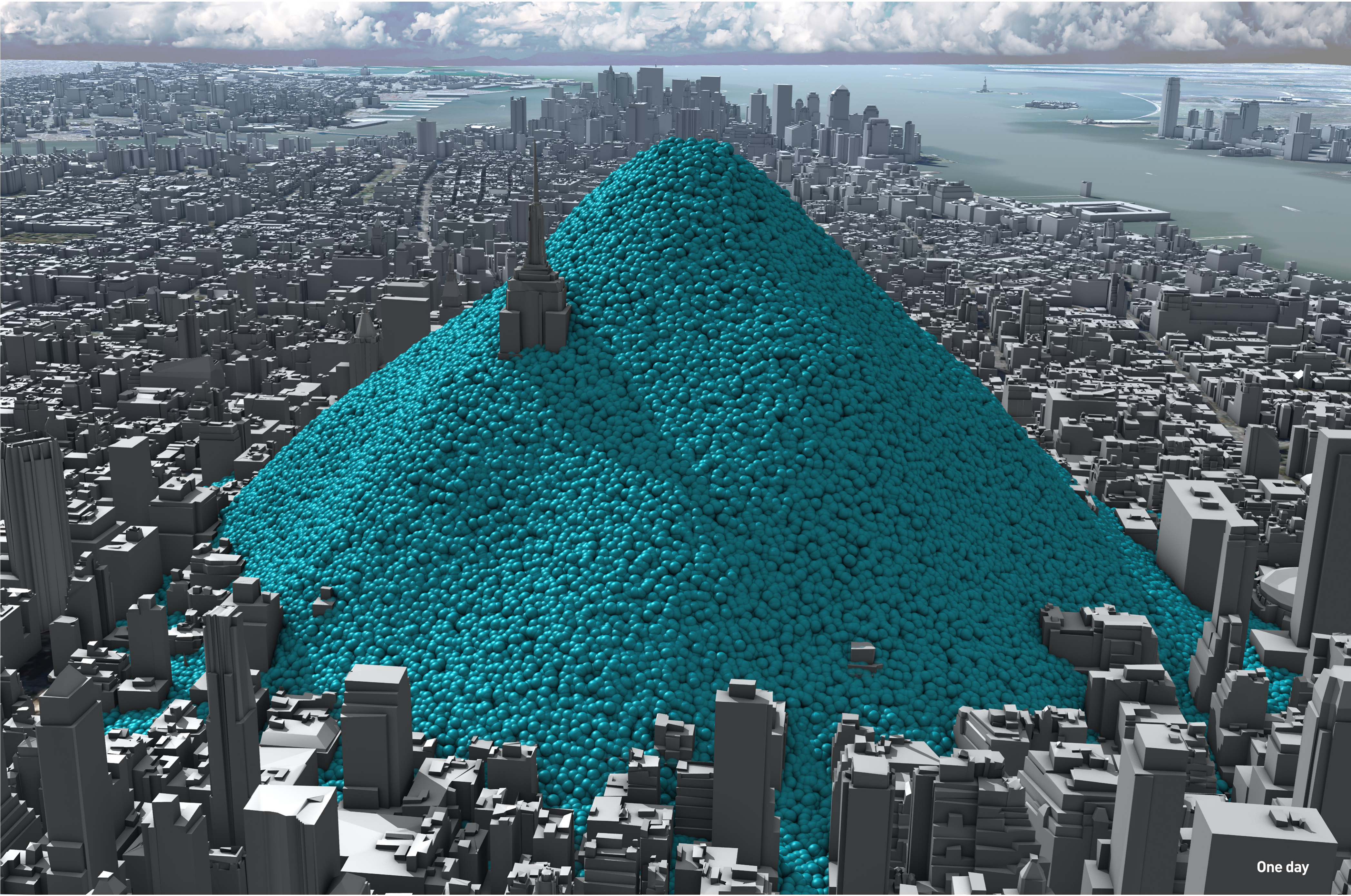


New York City's carbon emissions



Visualising a whole city's emissions

In 2010 New York City added 54 million tonnes of carbon dioxide to the atmosphere. That's nearly 2 tonnes a second. At standard pressure and 15 °C, one tonne of carbon dioxide gas would fill 10 metre sphere.
